- Student has to send application within the deadline
- Mobility Online sends information mail and confirmation of admission to accepted students – confirmation of admission is not sent to the home university but to the student

Should you choose this form of reservation, please mention that you are an ERASMUS+ Student from the Pädagogische Hochschule Niederösterreich (*University College of Education Lower Austria*). Please note that the institutions will require students to make a deposit. Please inform the International Office about your choice.

If these are occupied, the International Office cannot guarantee housing. Therefore, it is very important to register for a dorm room within the deadline. Students must apply directly to the student residence.

We encourage students to arrange accommodation as early as possible! It is extremely difficult to find reasonable accommodation close to semester start.

Language of Instruction

Our study programs are mainly conducted in German; only a selected number of courses is offered in English.

Learning Agreement

Learning Agreements are signed by the mobility coordinator. Nominated Erasmus students are encouraged to use the Online Learning Agreement (OLA) and will be informed about the contact data required to fill out the OLA.

Certificate of Attendance

From 2024/25 onwards we will be using automatized systems to electronically provide students with the Erasmus+ documents.

Transcript of Records

Transcript of Records are issued by our administration system PH-Online. Students are informed by the International Office what to do in order to receive a Transcript of Records.

Semester Fee

Erasmus students only have to pay a fee of approximately €22 per semester for the students' union membership. Neither tuition fees nor enrolment fees are charged.

Buddy Program

Our buddies are experienced students at the PH NÖ, who assist international students before and during their stay in Baden.
